Jayna, Inc. is a family owned and operated company here in Troy. They are a manufacturer of precision machined parts and assemblies. For over 20 years, Jayna, Inc. has specialized in high-volume production, CNC machining and assembly as a tier one supplier. They supply over 40 various machined components and assemblies exceeding an average of 70,000 parts per day. Jayna, Inc. utilizes over 125 varieties of CNC equipment for machining iron, steel, and aluminum components in the automotive and climate technologies industries.

RT started working with Jayna in 2020. RT Employment Specialist work directly with one of the owners, Soha. "Soha has taken time to understand the skill set of each person and adjust their position in their facility accordingly. She has been flexible with scheduling and responsive in communications." Jayna has hired 4 individuals who received Job Search Assistance through Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities provided by RT and given many tours to individuals who are interested in working there. The positions hired range from material handler, quality control, machine operator and janitorial.


