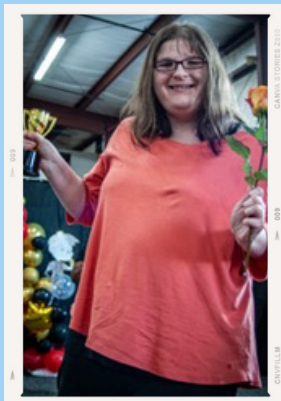
Also, our Employment Services Department, our HR Director and Business Director just went through the accreditation process with CARF this month. We are eager to find out and share our results.

This partnership allows us to provide on the job training and learn soft skills to help person's served further their career goals and one day lead them on the path to hold a job individually in the community.

Every Tuesday and Thursday RT's GES works at SEW. The job tasks are to place gaskets on the parts and use a hand drill to place four screws into the part. The group works together to complete the job tasks assigned to them by their supervisor. Each person's served not only make money, they also can use their job experience to build a resume.

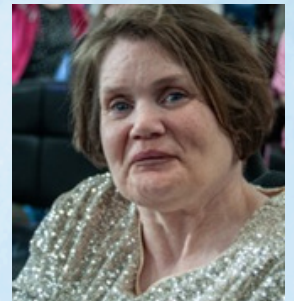
# RT's Got Talent

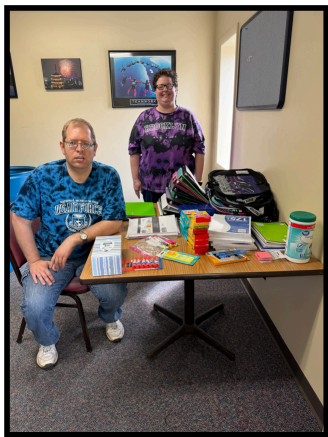
